Reservations and Payment:

1. Reservations may be made at our website, www.hico-tx.com, or by calling City Hall.
2. If you didn't make an advance reservation, please call (254)-796-4620, come by City Hall or pay our park attendant as he makes the rounds.
3. No refunds.

Rules:

1. 2:00 p.m. check-in and 1:00 p.m. check-out.
2. Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
3. Children must be under adult supervision.
4. Pets are allowed provided you:
 - a. Keep them on a leash or otherwise restrained at all times (per City Ordinance).
 - b. Clean up after them.
 - c. Don't leave them unattended except inside your RV.
 - d. Keep them from being a nuisance to other campers by preventing noisy or unruly behavior.
6. Please dispose of trash and litter in our dumpster.
7. While in our campground, please do not:
 - a. Build fires, except in fire rings or grills, or leave fires unattended.
 - b. Keep more than one RV and one additional motor vehicle at your campsite.
 - c. Wash your vehicle or RV.
 - d. Set up a clotheslines or otherwise arrange to dry your laundry, other than towels or swim wear, outdoors.
 - e. Store your belongings outside of your vehicle or RV.
 - f. Discharge a firearm or use fireworks.
 - g. Create noise nuisances (prohibited by City Ordinance) or operate your generator during quiet hours.
8. Stays must be limited to no more than 180 days in any one calendar year.
9. Anyone failing to make payment, refusing to comply with the above rules or engaging in obnoxious or disruptive behavior is subject to expulsion.
